Special Considerations and Protocols		
Coverage Area	Action Sports EMS covers the entire property to include grand stand and public areas. Any 911 call from the pits may be directed to our service. Any request for help or mutual aid from Med91 is to be treated as any other mutual aid or 911 response call.	
Transports	All transports should be taken to the closest facility. Call the ER for medical direction so they can choose to divert the patient to Air Services or demand we meet with a Paramedic intercept. Use the ER Report Line to provide patient reports.	
Intercept	Intercepts take place with Med91 at the top of the track entrance on the paved road.	
Route of Travel	South or (Left) on Hwy 45 to the stop light, turn left or East to the hospital. 1/2 mile total transport.	
Air Landing Zone	Managed by local ambulance, all patient are to be transported to the ER where they can be stabilized, treated and then transferred to Air Medical at an off site landing zone.
